

Instructor Position

Responsibilities:

- Lead fun and informative musicin classes like Brass, Percussion, Piano, Dance, Drama, and Guitar.
- Help with the choir by singing in classes.
- Teach music theory to beginners and those at an intermediate level, usually with another instructor.
- Make effective lesson plans for your classes.
- Assist with daily Bible study and devotions.
- Take an active role in camp activities and classes, providing support and guidance to the campers.

Qualifications:

- Experience and interest in teaching music.
- Previous teaching experience and good communication skills with campers of different ages and skill levels.
- A strong desire to inspire young musicians and foster a love for music and the performing arts.

Pay:

- Competitive salary based on your experience and skills.
- Early sign-on bonus also available.

Time Off and Breaks:

- There are scheduled breaks during the camp to rest and recharge.
- 4 days off will be scheduled throughout the summer.

Accommodation and Team:

- Staff work with a team of fellow music instructors and counselors in a supportive and cooperative environment.
- Staff stay in on-site accommodation.
- Meals provided for all staff, eaten with the campers.
- On-site free parking available for staff.







Counselor Position

Responsibilities:

- Monitor campers overnight, ensuring their safety and well-being throughout the camp.
- Work with other counselors to create and stick to a cabin schedule that includes various activities and rest periods.
- Take an active role in camp activities and classes, providing support and guidance to the campers.
- Use good communication and problem-solving skills to address any issues among campers.
- Assist with daily Bible study and devotions to help the campers with their spiritual growth and create a positive camp community.

Qualifications:

- Good people skills and a genuine love for working with children.
- Ability to create a positive and inclusive environment, promoting teamwork and personal development among the campers.

Pay:

- Competitive salary based on your experience and skills.
- Counselors receive a \$575 bonus at the end of the summer.
- · Early sign-on bonus also available.

Time Off and Breaks:

- Counselors get two scheduled breaks each day.
- 4 scheduled days off during the summer.

Accommodation and Team:

- Each cabin has a team of three counselors responsible for 15-18 campers. Counselors will share their own room and bathroom in cabin building near campers living area.
- Meals provided for all staff and eaten with the campers.
- On-site parking available for staff.

We encourage individuals with a love for music, dance, or theater to apply. Above all, we seek patient and dedicated team members who are eager to contribute to an unforgettable summer camp experience for our campers.



Major Class Explanations

Brass and Percussion

Brass and percussion tracks auditions place students in three bands: Heaton (novice), Leidzen (intermediate), and Ray-Steadman Allen (advanced). Bands perform challenging music, accompany hymns, and have many performances.



Guitar

The Guitar Major is for current guitar students looking to expand their skills. They work toward performances each week, accompanying singing and participating in contemporary worship.

Piano

The Piano track develops church pianists to accompany singing and provide special selections. The track accommodates 10 students with varying proficiency levels in our keyboard lab.

Dance

The Dance track is geared to students who want to hone their skills in this area and really explore the various styles and how they can be used to enhance worship.

Drama

Participants in the Drama track explore script acting and the role of drama in enriching worship services. They collaborate on a full-scale production at the camp's end and present weekly at the visited corps.

Electives Class Explanations

Timbrels - Instruct students in modern Timbrel drills, a vibrant expression of The Salvation Army's heritage.

Praise Band - Guide campers through contemporary worship music and performance opportunities.

Dance - Foster a love for dance in a supportive environment for campers of all skill levels.

Piano - Lead group piano sessions, cultivating a passion for music and enhancing technical skills.

Guitar - Encourage musical exploration and collaboration among campers of all playing abilities.

Handbells - Inspire camaraderie and teamwork through the unique sounds of a Handbell Ensemble.

Electives usually depend on our staff's interest as well! We love offering opportunities for them to teach. Some other classes have been Karate, Spanish, Color Guard, etc...
